OHIO KINDERGARTEN AGE

In case you are not aware, Ohio's new House Bill 114, signed in late 2025, standardizes kindergarten age by requiring children to be 5 years old by the first day of school for the 2026-2027 school year and beyond, replacing varied district cutoffs and potentially impacting enrollment for some families.

NHPEC will be staying with our current entrance ages for the 2026-2027 school year and evaluate if any changes need to be made for the 2027-28 school year. Please contact the office if you have any questions.
